## **Pulp Clamp**

Pulp Clamp - There are actually several other forklift attachments that can be used in order to make lift trucks rather more effective. Snowplow accessories can be mounted onto the front of a lift truck. A scoop bucket can be helpful when the task requires transferring sand, gravel, soil or snow. A double block handler allows the person operating the forklift to pick up 2 loads and stack them beside each other. Many of these attachments are extremely ideal for light to medium tasks.

One more lift truck attachment is the package lift clamp, which can lift and transfer really heavy pallets. Moreover, pallet crane forks could be utilized in order to carry and transfer pallets with an overhead crane. A drum clamp accessory is useful for transferring very heavy drums from one place to another without having to utilize a pallet. Forklift mounted hoppers enable material to be moved and dumped without having to do it manually. These hoppers are self dumping when the bumper is released.

There are even attachments accessible that could transform the lift truck into a commercial broom or mop. Such accessories are ideal for cleaning boat docks, warehouse flooring and parking areas. Forklift mounted platforms are available geared up with twin entry doors and could be attached to be able to transport personnel from one area to another. The mounted platform accessory is nice for reaching parts which can be hard to access, particularly when you've got merchandise or supplies stored in out of the way places or way up high.

Attachments could be a very useful piece of equipment when put in a lift truck, transforming an typical lift truck right into a mobile crane unit. It is most useful when transferring uneven or tricky loads. This attachment could either be telescopic, mounted on the carriage itself, or be fixed or even lift truck mounted.
